INTENDED USE

Your Black & Decker Dustbuster[®] auto car vacuum cleaner has been designed for light dry vacuum cleaning purposes. The appliance is powered from a car electrical system and connected by the cigarette lighter socket. This appliance is intended for household use only.

GENERAL SAFETY RULES

- ▲ Warning! When using mains-powered/cordless appliances, basic safety precautions, including the following, should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, personal injury and material damage.
- Read all of this manual carefully before using the appliance.
- The intended use is described in this manual. The use of any accessory or attachment or the performance of any operation with this appliance other than those recommended in this instruction manual may present a risk of personal injury.

The term "appliance" in the warnings refers to your mains-operated (corded) appliance or battery-operated (cordless) appliance.

SAVE ALL WARNINGS AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE REFERENCE.

1. Work area safety

Always take care when using the appliance.

- a. Keep work area clean and well lit. Cluttered or dark areas invite accidents.
- **b.** Only use the appliance in daylight or good artifical light.
- c. Do not operate your appliance in explosive atmospheres, such as in the presence of flammable liquids, gases or dust.
- **d.** Never allow children or people unfamiliar with the instructions to use the appliance.
- **e.** Do not allow children or animals to come near the work area or touch the appliance supply cord.
- Keep children, bystanders and animals away while operating an appliance. Distractions can cause you to lose control.

- g. The appliance is not to be used as a toy.
- h. Do not immerse the appliance in water.
- i. Do not open body casing. There are no user-serviceable parts inside.
- 2. Electrical safety
- a. Appliance plugs must match the outlet. Never modify the plug in any way. Do not use any adapter plugs with earthed (grounded) power tools. Unmodified plugs and matching outlets will reduce risk of electric shock.
- b. Avoid body contact with earthed or grounded surfaces, such as pipes, radiators, ranges and refrigerators. There is an increased risk of electric shock if your body is earthed or grounded.
- c. Do not expose appliance to rain or wet conditions. Water entering a power tool will increase the risk of electric shock.
- d. Do not abuse the cord. Never use the cord for carrying, pulling or unplugging the appliance. Keep cord away from heat, oil, sharp edges or moving parts. Damaged or entangled cords increase the risk of electric shock.
- e. When operating an appliance outdoors, use an extension cord suitable for outdoor use. Use of a cord suitable for outdoor use reduces the risk of electric shock.
- f. If operating a power tool in a damp location is unavoidable, use a residual current device (RCD) protected supply. Use of an RCD reduces the risk of electric shock.
- 3. Personal safety
- a. Stay alert, watch what you are doing and use common sense when operating a power tool. Do not use a power tool while you are tired or under the influence of drugs, alcohol or medication. A moment of inattention while operating power tools may result in serious personal injury.
- b. Prevent unintentional starting. Ensure the switch is in the off-position before connecting to power source and/or battery pack, picking up or carrying the tool. Carrying power tools with your finger on the switch or energising power tools that have the switch on invites accidents.
- c. Remove any adjusting key or wrench before turning the power tool on. A wrench or a key left attached to a rotating part of the power tool may result in personal injury.
- d. Do not overreach. Keep proper footing and balance at all times. This enables better control of the power tool in unexpected situations.

- e. Dress properly. Do not wear loose clothing or jewellery. Keep your hair, clothing and gloves away from moving parts. Loose clothes, jewellery or long hair can be caught in moving parts.
- f. If devices are provided for the connection of dust extraction and collection facilities, ensure these are connected and properly used. Use of dust collection can reduce dust-related hazards.
- 4. Appliance use and care
- a. Before use, check the appliance for damaged or defective parts. Check for breakage of parts, damage to switches and any other conditions that may affect its operation.
- b. Do not use the appliance if the switch does not turn it on and off. Any appliance that cannot be controlled with the switch is dangerous and must be repaired.
- c. Disconnect the plug from the power source and/or the battery pack from the appliance before making any adjustments, changing accessories, or storing appliances. Such preventive safety measures reduce the risk of starting the appliance accidentally.
- **d.** Where applicable, keep cutting tools sharp and clean. Properly maintained cutting tools with sharp cutting edges are less likely to bind and are easier to control.
- **e.** Do not use the appliance if any part is damaged or defective.
- f. Have any damaged or defective parts repaired or replaced by an authorised repair agent.
- **g.** Never attempt to remove or replace any parts other than those specified in this manual.

5. Service

a. Have your appliance serviced by a qualified repair person using only identical replacement parts. This will ensure that the safety of the power tool is maintained.

After use

- When not in use, the appliance should be stored in a dry, well ventilated place out of the reach of children.
- Children should not have access to stored appliances.
- When the appliance is stored or transported in a vehicle it should be placed in the boot or restrained to prevent movement following sudden changes in speed or direction.

Safety of others

 This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning the use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

Inspection and repairs

- Before use, check the appliance for damaged or defective parts. Check for breakage of parts, damage to switches and any other conditions that may affect its operation.
- Do not use the appliance if any part is damaged or defective.
- Have any damaged or defective parts repaired or replaced by an authorized repair agent.
- Regularly check the power cord for damage.
- Never attempt to remove or replace any parts other than those specified in this manual.

Additional safety instructions for accessory plugs and sockets

To reduce the risk of fire make sure that the 12Vdc outlet is free from debris and when the adapter plug is fitted, make sure that it is a tight connection.

Electrical safety

The appliance is designed for use with 12V negative ground vehicle battery systems.

Warning! The cigarette lighter connector is fitted with a nonserviceable safety fuse. The fuse may operate in the event of a fault. If this occurs the fuse must be replaced together with the connector and cable by the manufacturer or an authorised Black and Decker Service Centre in order to avoid a hazard.

Warning! Do not operate the appliance with systems which have positive ground or a different voltage.

Assembly

Adjusting the dust collector (fig. B)

- The dust collector (8) is stored under the appliance. To adjust for use, press the collector lock button (3) and rotate the dust collector to the required position.
- Release the collector lock button (3) to lock the dust collector (8) in position.
- The dust collector (8) can be extended by pulling the dust collector extension (7) until it locks into position.
- The extension can be retracted by pressing the button (14) and pushing the extension (7) back into the dust collector.
- The dust collector (8) should be returned to the storage position under the appliance after use.

Fitting the accessories (fig. C & D)

The appliance is supplied with the following accessories:

- Two brush tools (10 & 11) for upholstery
- An extension hose (12)
- A hose connector (13)

Note: The brush tool (10) can be fitted into the front of the appliance, the right-angled brush tool (11) can be fitted to the end of the extension hose (12).

To fit an accessory, proceed as follows:

- Insert the brush (10) into the front of the appliance.
- Alternatively, fit the hose connector (13) onto the nose of the appliance and attach one end of the hose (12) to the connector.
- Attach the right-angled brushtool (11) to the other end of the hose.
- When not in use, the accessories can be stored in the storage bag (9).

Use

Connecting to the vehicle's power supply (fig. E)

- Make sure that the appliance is switched off.
- Remove the cigarette lighter from it's socket.
- Plug the connector (6) into the cigarette lighter socket.

Switching on and off (fig. F)

- To switch on, slide the on/off switch (4) forward.
- To switch off, slide the on/off switch back.

The appliance can be used for periods of up to 30 minutes without noticeably affecting the power of a normally charged car battery in good condition.

Warning! Extended use will drain the battery power. Do not run the vehicle's engine whilecleaning as this can shorten the life of the appliance.

Optimising the suction force (fig. G)

In order to keep the suction force optimised, the filters must be cleared regularly during use.

 Rotate the filter cleaning wheel (5) a few turns to shake out dust clogging the filters (15 & 16).

Cleaning and maintenance

Warning! Regularly clean the filters (15 & 16).

Cleaning the dust bowl and filters (fig. H - I)

The filters are re-usable and should be cleaned regularly.

- Press the release latch (1) and open the container door (2) (fig. H).
- Empty the dust container.
- Remove the filters (15 & 16) by twisting them counterclockwise (fig.l).
- Brush any loose dust off the filters.
- Wash the filters in warm, soapy water (fig.J).
- Make sure that the filters are dry.
- Refit the filters (15 & 16) on to the appliance, twisting them clockwise until they lock into place.
- Close the container door (2). Make sure that the release latch (1) clicks into place.

Warning! Never use the appliance without the filters. Optimum dust collection wilbnly be achieved with clean filters.

Replacing the filters

The filters should be replaced every 6 to 9 months and whenever worn or damaged. Replacement filters are available from your Black & Decker dealer (cat. no. VF50):

- Remove the old filters as described above.
- Fit the new filters as described above.

Important

To ensure product SAFETY and RELIABILITY, repairs, maintenance and adjustment (other than those listed in this manual) should be performed by authorized service centers or other qualified organizations, always-using identical replacement parts. Unit contains no user serviceable parts inside.

PROTECTING THE ENVIRONMENT

设计用途

本百得车载电动吸尘器是设计用以吸取轻型干物。本款 产品通过点烟器插座连接汽车电源,仅限家用。

组装

调整吸尘咀(图 B)

- 吸尘咀(8)设于产品底部。需要使用时,按下吸 尘咀锁定钮(3)将吸尘咀旋转到所需位置。
- 松开吸尘咀锁定钮(3),锁定吸尘咀(8)位置。
- 吸尘咀(8)内备有可延伸缝隙吸尘咀(7),使用 时将其拉出到位。
- 按下按钮(14)可把延伸缝隙吸尘咀(7)推回原 位。
- 使用完毕后,需将吸尘咀(8)收回到产品底部的 存放位置。

组装配件 (图 C 和 D)

本产品配有以下配件:

- 用于清理的毛刷两把(10 和 11)
- 延伸软管(12)



软管接头(13)

注意:毛刷(10)可以安装到本产品前端,直角刷(11) 可安装在延伸软管的末端。

安装步骤如下:

- 将毛刷(10)插入本产品前端。
- 另外,将软管接头接在吸尘咀上,并将软管的一端
 同接头相连。
- 将直角刷(11)接到软管的另一端。

使用步骤

连接到汽车电源(图E)

- 确保本产品处于关闭状态。
- 将点烟器从插座上取出。
- 把连接器(6)接入点烟器插座。

开关(图F)

- 开启,将开关(4)向前推。
- 关闭,将开关往后推回。

在正常情况下,本产品最多可使用 30 分钟,并对汽车 电池没有任何不良影响。

警告!使用时间过长将耗光电池电量。请勿在清洁时发 动汽车引擎,否则将缩短本产品的使用寿命。

优化吸力(图G)

为了保持产品良好的吸力,在使用过程中滤尘网必须定 期清理。

旋转滤尘网洁净转轮(5)数周,以抖落依附在滤
 尘网上的灰尘(图 15 和 16)。

清洗和保养

警告!请定期清洗滤尘网(15和16)。

清洗集尘碗和滤尘网(图 H-I)

滤尘网可重复使用,并应定期清洗。

- ◆ 按下集尘碗闩锁(1),打开集尘碗盖(2)(图 H)。
- 将集尘碗内的灰尘清空。
- 逆时针转动滤尘网(15和16),并将它们卸下(图 I)。
- 把依附在滤尘网上的灰尘刷掉。
- 用温肥皂水清洗滤尘网(图 J)。
- 确保滤尘网全部干透。
- 将滤尘网(15和16)装回吸尘器内,顺时针旋转 直到锁定位置。
- 关闭集尘碗盖(2),并确保集尘碗闩锁(1)到位。

警告!切勿使用未安装滤尘网的吸尘器。 清洁的滤尘网才可使吸尘器达到最佳使用效果。

更换滤尘网

滤尘网应每六到九个月或损坏时更换,新的滤尘网可至 百得经销商处购买(型号 VF50)。

- 如上文所述步骤卸下滤尘网。
- 如上文所述步骤安装新滤尘网。
